solving the cistern problem

You've probably faced the problem dozens of times. In order to obtain the look you want, you need to specify Product A - but budget restrictions often mean that the finished design must be compromised by specifying the more cost effective Product B. Concealed cisterns are nothing new and specification of back to wall and wall-hung pans greatly enhances the look of the bathroom - be it domestic, commercial or hotel - but traditional models have two major drawbacks. The first is the need to cut an access/inspection hole in the vanity top and insert an expensive colour matched cover - hardly ideal. The second problem is the time it takes to assemble the cistern itself. With the CITB forecasting the need for an additional 6000 plumbers qualified to NVQ Level 3 per year for the next five years, the shortage of installers and rising installation costs are becoming important considerations.

Thomas Dudley Ltd, a company with over eighty years experience in manufacturing flushing WC

cisterns, have launched their new Vantage concealed cistern with the objective of overcoming these problem areas. The Vantage can be installed and maintained via a removable front panel, so that the cistern can be hidden away behind fitted units in the same way kitchen appliances are hidden. This leaves continuous vanity tops free from unsightly inspection covers and lids.

Thomas Dudley also developed the installer-friendly Vantage with the shortage of skilled plumbers firmly in

mind. Several time saving features have been incorporated to minimise installation time and costs. The Vantage is supplied factory assembled, removing the need for the plumber to assemble and fit the float valve and flush valve on site. Snap-fit fixing brackets are supplied, and once screwed in place, the cistern is quickly and simply clipped in. A Speedfit® elbow is provided as standard, allowing instant connection to the water inlet pipe, and the 90 degree tight radius flushbend allows installation in units as low as 800mm.

Vantage from Thomas Dudley solves both cost and design problems in concealed cistern installations.

Every Vantage concealed cistern is supplied with both front and top access panels. This not only enables neat installations into 500mm minimum width furniture units, it also provides an ideal solution where the cistern needs to be hidden behind partitions, walls or used in other confined spaces. The cistern is

operated by a pneumatic push button for the latest look and is fitted with the new Dudley Hydroflo float valve for an exceptionally quiet after-flush fill.
